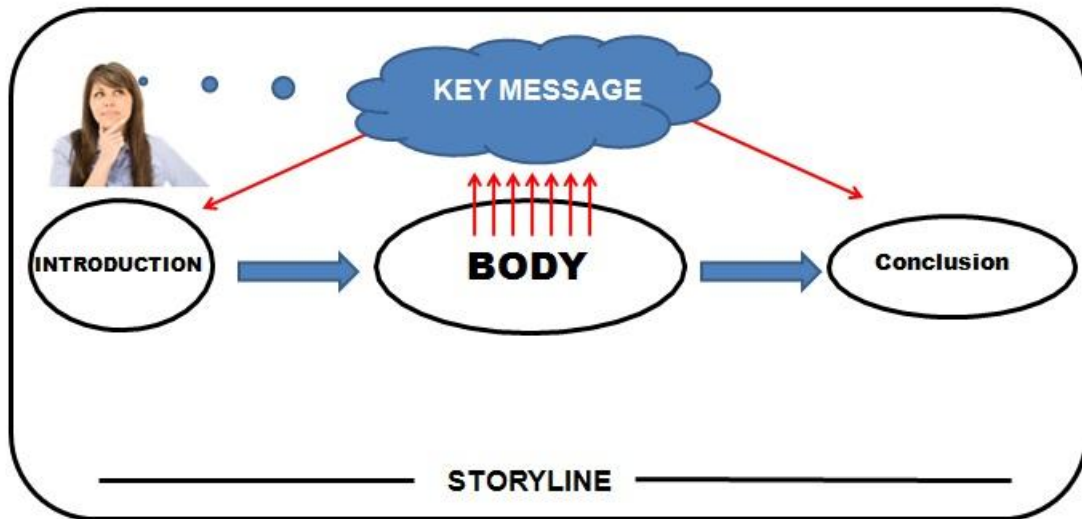

Presentation requirements

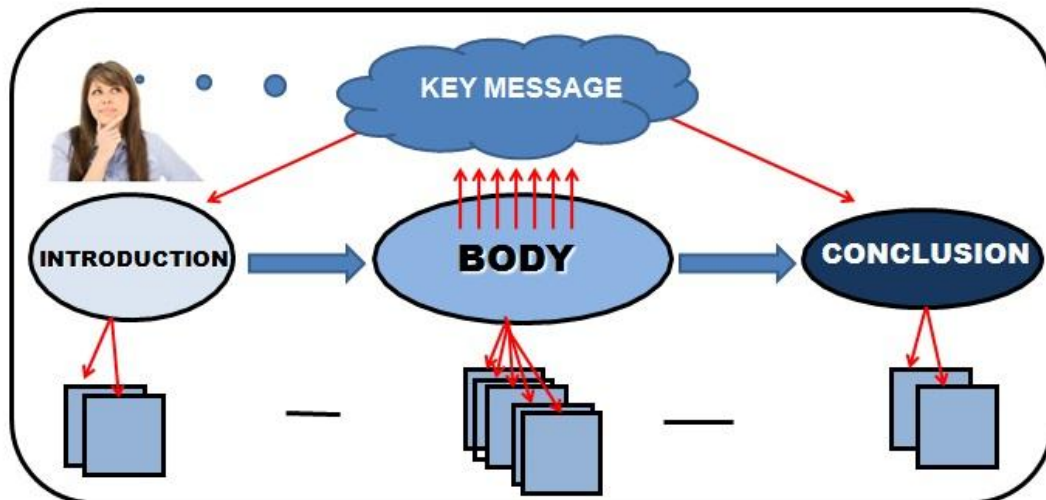
Storyline

“Key message” in major parts



Storyboard

Visualize the storyline into a storyboard



“Storyline” (not the number of slides)

1. *Title slide: Topic, Presenters, Departments, School*
2. *What are the objectives of your presentation? What are you going to talk about and why? Why should we listen to your presentation? What is the key message of your presentation?*

3. Some important facts about your topic
(name of the molecule, origin of the name, structure, chemistry etc.)
4. History and discovery of the molecule
(How long has it been known? When was it discovered? Who discovered it? How was it discovered? Why was it difficult to discover it? How long has it been used? etc.)
5. Main applications of the molecule in pharmacy / healthcare / research / life
(What is the molecule used for? What are the most common side-effects of the molecule? What are the administration routes and important formulation of the molecule? How has the discovery changed our lives? What is the result of the discovery? etc.)
6. Other specific important information, interesting facts related to the molecule

7. *What should we remember from your presentation? Why is your presentation important for us? What is your key message?*
8. *(Acknowledgements)*
