English	Meaning in English	Japanese
compound (n)	a thing consisting of two or more separate things combined together	
understandable (adj)	(of behaviour, feelings, reactions, etc.) seeming normal and reasonable in a particular situation	
(to) isolate	to separate a single substance, cell, etc. from others so that you can study it	
belief (n)	an opinion about sth; sth that you think is true	
vital (adj)	necessary or essential in order for sth to succeed or exist	
inherent in	that is a basic or permanent part of sb/sth and that cannot be removed	
synthesis (n)	the artificial production of a substance that is present naturally in animals and plants	
synthesize (v)	to produce a substance by means of chemical or biological processes	
substance (n)	a type of solid, liquid or gas that has particular qualities	
scope (n)	the opportunity or ability to do or achieve sth	
evaporate (v)	if a liquid evaporates or if sth evaporates it, it changes into a gas, especially steam	
experiment (n)	a scientific test that is carried out in order to study what happens and to gain new knowledge	
aqueous (adj)	containing water; like water	
mineral (n)	a substance that is naturally present in the earth and is not formed from animal or vegetable matter, for example gold and salt	
contrary to sth	different from sth; against sth	
evidence (n)	the facts, signs or objects that make you believe that sth is true	
(to) prepare (sth from)	to make a medicine or chemical substance, for example by mixing other substances together	
(to) discover	to find out about sth; to find some information about sth	
discovery (n)	a thing, fact or person that is found or learned about for the first time	
subsequent (adj)	happening after sth else	
eventually (ad)	at the end of a period of time or a series of events
