Deadly Pharmacy Errors

English	Meaning in English	Japanese
1. epidemic	<i>a sudden rapid increase in how often something bad happens</i>	
2. dose / dosage	<i>an amount of a medicine or a drug that is taken once, or regularly over a period of time</i>	
3. life expectancy	<i>the number of years that a person is likely to live; the length of time that something is likely to exist or continue for</i>	
4. phenobarbital	<i>a long-acting oral or parenteral sedative, anticonvulsant, and hypnotic; also available as a soluble sodium salt; also used in therapeutic management of epilepsy</i>	
5. seizure	<i>a sudden attack of an illness, especially one that affects the brain</i>	
6. investigation	<i>a scientific or academic examination of the facts of a subject or problem</i>	
7. brain damage	<i>permanent damage to the brain caused by illness or an accident</i>	
8. diabetes	<i>a medical condition caused by a lack of insulin</i>	
9. insulin	<i>a chemical substance produced in the body that controls the amount of sugar absorbed by the blood</i>	
10. premature (of a birth or a baby)	<i>being born before the normal length of pregnancy has been completed</i>	
11. precaution	<i>something that is done in advance in order to prevent problems or to avoid danger</i>	
12. error	<i>mistake, especially one that causes problems or affects the result of sth</i>	
13. chemotherapy	<i>the treatment of disease, especially cancer, with the use of chemical substances</i>	
14. stroke	<i>a sudden serious illness when a blood vessel in the brain bursts or is blocked, which can cause death or the loss of the ability to move or to speak clearly</i>	
15. crippled	<i>a person who is unable to walk or move normally because of a disease or injury</i>	
16. injury	<i>harm done to a person's or an animal's body, for example in an accident</i>	
17. tremendous	<i>very great</i>	
18. testify	<i>to make a statement that sth happened or that sth is true, especially as a witness in a court of law</i>
