emphasis (n)	<i>special importance that is given to sth</i>	
dissolution (n)	<i>the process in which sth gradually disappears</i>	
activity (n)	<i>a measure of the physiological response a drug produces</i>	
intestine (n)	<i>a long tube in the body between the stomach and the anus</i>	
postulate (v)	<i>to suggest or accept that sth is true so that it can be used as the basis for a theory, etc.</i>	
demonstrate (v)	<i>to show and explain how sth works or how to do sth</i>	
bioavailability (n)	<i>the physiologic availability of a given amount of a drug, as distinct from its chemical potency; proportion of the administered dose that is absorbed into the bloodstream</i>	
analgesic (n)	<i>a substance that reduces pain</i>	
sustain (v)	<i>to make sth continue for some time without becoming less</i>	
release (n)	<i>the act of letting a gas, chemical, etc. come out of the container where it has been safely held</i>	
confirm (v)	<i>to make a position, an agreement, etc. more definite or official; to establish sb/sth firmly</i>	
pharmacology (n)	<i>the scientific study of drugs and their use in medicine</i>	
significant (adj)	<i>large or important enough to have an effect or to be noticed</i>	
discipline (n)	<i>an area of knowledge; a subject that people study or are taught, especially in a university</i>	
mandatory (adj)	<i>required by law</i>	
correlation (n)	<i>connection between two things in which one thing changes as the other does</i>	
predictor (n)	<i>something that can show what will happen in the future</i>	
therapeutic (adj)	<i>designed to help treat an illness</i>	
efficiency (n)	<i>the quality of doing sth well with no waste of time or money</i>	
qualitative (adj)	<i>connected with how good sth is, rather than with how much of it there is</i>	
consistency (n)	<i>the quality of always behaving in the same way</i>	
accuracy (n)	<i>the state of being exact or correct; the ability to do sth skilfully without making mistakes</i>
